



INVITATION AND CALL FOR PAPERS

The **International Society for the Philosophy of Law and Social Philosophy (IVR)** is accepting submissions for individual papers and group sessions (special workshops), to be presented at the XXVII World Congress this summer in **Washington, DC, from 27 July – 1 August 2015**. The theme for the meeting is “**Law, Reason, and Emotion**,” but papers and panels need not be restricted to this theme.

The rules for submitting papers are as follows:

- Abstracts must be in English, French, Spanish, or German and under 400 words.
- There are no specific formatting requirements.
- Papers may have more than one author.
- There is no limit to the number of papers per author.

- Papers must be submitted by ~~March 15, 2015~~, to: submissions@ivr2015.org
